

Atlanta Collective Impact for CS/STEM Flash Talks

Each participant or group/team is being asked to create a Flash Talk about your proposed Collective Impact initiative and its necessary Backbone Functions. These can be seen as brief “pitches” that you can use in the future to enroll more stakeholders and/or funders.

The “Flash Talk” is a five-minute presentation that you can do using a flip chart or using a power point presentation or just from your notes. These presentations will be made the morning of the second day from 8:30am to 12:00pm on Friday, March 3rd.

Because you’re “pitching” your ideas to an audience, feel free to make these presentations fast-paced and creative!

Flash Talk Slide Guidelines

- Five minutes to present
- Let us know if you will be doing a presentation using ppt or flipchart or your notes
- Presentation should cover the following:
 - Name of initiative and a song that could best represent the theme of the initiative (song name is optional...but fun 😊)
 - Result to be achieved (impact, population, timeline)
 - Leads, partners and their organizations/institutions and roles
 - Strategies to used
 - Backbone functions necessary to implement strategies and achieve result
 - How can others partner with your initiative?
